Dear Frank:

Almost 3 weeks in the hoongow now and am glad to say we are still okay. We've had little time to think things over, but we cannot think otherwise that than that we are on the right track of mind. We have discussions every night discussing pro & con and the time passes rather fast.

○ Nice place this jail. It's a little smaller than Ft. Mt. but there aint a hell of a lot of difference between jails. The sheriff and all concerned are no more its a hell of a lot better, than being under the damn W.R.A. These people here are human

Not beasts. I had almost forgotten
there were human beings until I
came to this jail, because of being
under inhuman beings so long.

What do you think of the last
Sentinel issue. Very considerate
scope, these people of the Sentinel.
They threw us in here and now
they want to save us. They said
we should be punished and fine ^{by} ~~by~~
now we are worth saving. What the
hell do they want. Well I think its
needless to mention any further about
the position the dam paper is taking.
I think we're going to have a
friendly enemy visitor, a stool for the
W.R.A. in the near future from the
way the editorial sounds. We are
just gonna be good listeners
this time. Our time to speak
is yet coming. If I were a normal

We no sorry.

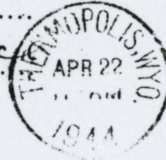
Well so much now just a note to
