



Ukachi Tamesa one of the first Japanese farmers in the Sunnydale area, had a 2,000 chicken ranch which provided a livelihood for him and his family. Tamesa sold his white leghorns in Seattle at the Pike Place Market. He came to Sunnydale in 1908, was the only one in the entire area to have a Kelly truck. In this 1912 photo his son, Minoru and daughter Kay, helped tend the chickens, or just played amongst them.
