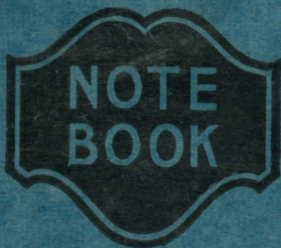

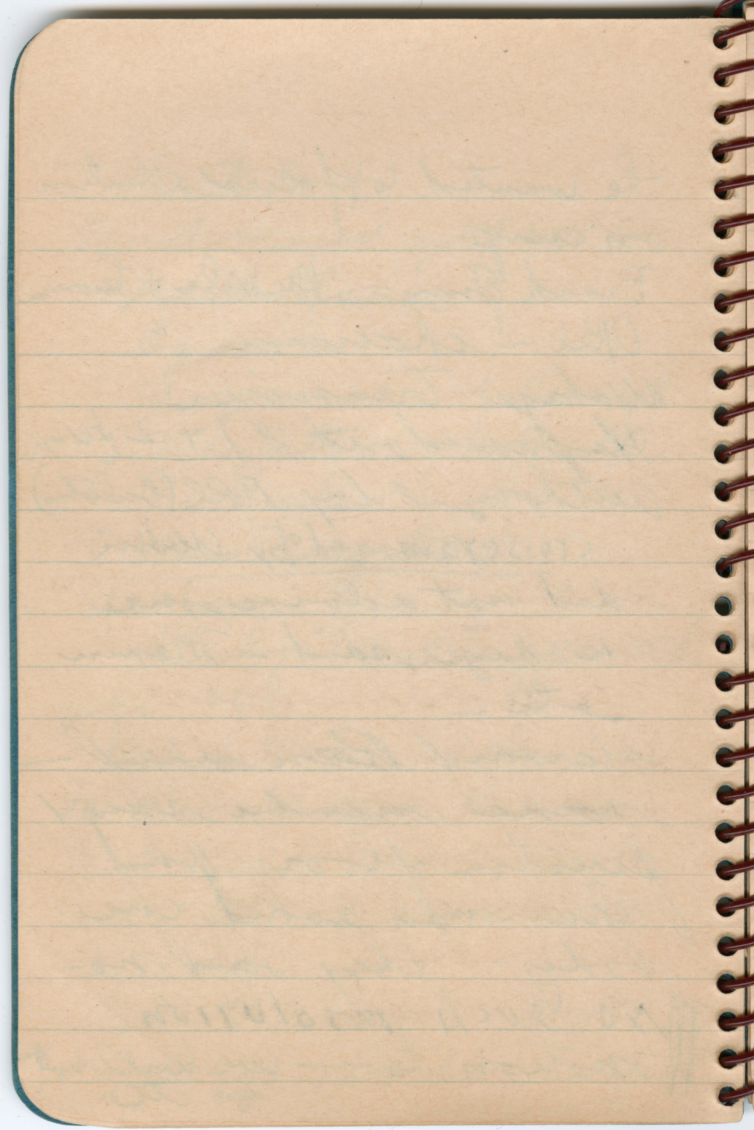

want to involve others.

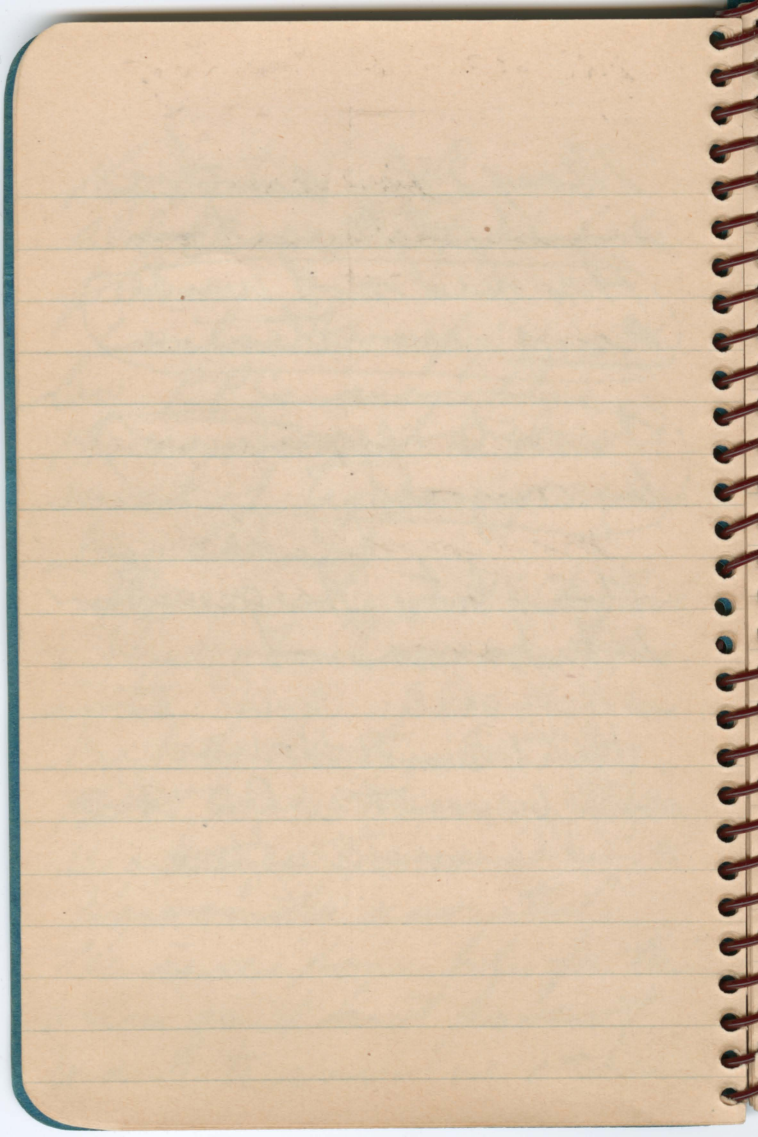

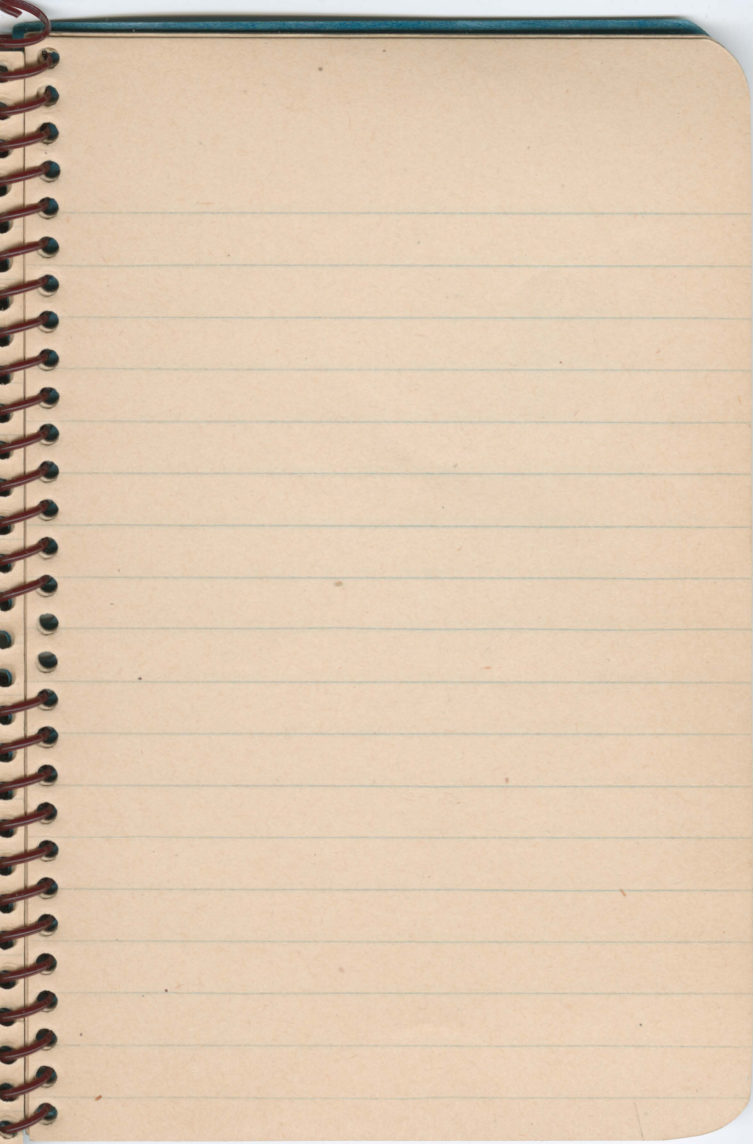

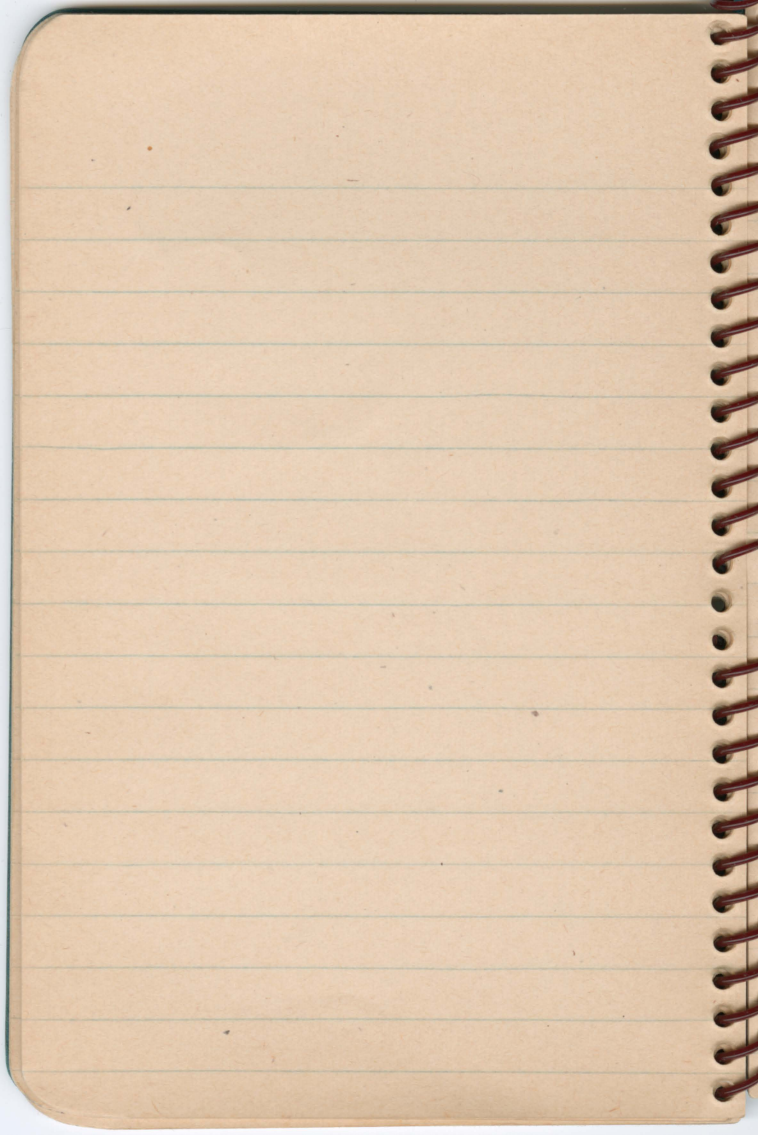
