You are informed that the appointment of Mr. W. A. Lookingbill
or Route No. 1, Twin Falls, Idaho as sponsor in your case has been
approved by this office. In view thereof he will have immediate super-
vision over your parole and you should consult him for assistance and
advice relative to any problems which might arise in connection there-
with.

Under the conditions of your parole you are required to sub-
mit reports to this office once each month. You are informed that
forms for that purpose have been furnished to your sponsor, who will
instruct you in their preparation and also furnish you with whatever
assistance may be necessary.

You are advised that your release on parole does not exempt
you from the regulations governing the conduct of aliens of enemy
nationalities. Therefore, you should carefully observe such regula-
tions as well as the conditions of your parole, as any violations of
either will make you subject to reinternment for the duration of the
war.

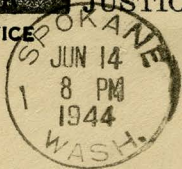
